

COVID 19 Response for Training 2020/2021

Safe return to the Classroom

We are working hard with our hotels, facilities and instructors to develop preventative measures that will keep operators safe and comply with the latest government regulations.

The following safety measures will be in place for fall 2020 classroom training. The Association will continue to update these measures as additional information becomes available.

Safety Measures



Reduced Classroom Sizes

- All 2020 fall training will take place with 50% capacity and in compliance with provincial guidelines
- Only one student will be permitted to sit per table.

Keep 2M apart – Physical Distancing



Reduced Physical Contact

- Reduced sharing of common items
- Course evaluations and completion certificates will be e-mailed following successful course completion.



Hand Sanitizer Provided for Each Student

- To encourage regular hand-washing, each student will be encouraged to use hand sanitizer provided.

Masks Available

- Wearing a mask or face covering will be mandatory in all indoor public places. If you are not able to provide your own mask or covering, the Association will be providing free masks for each day of training.



Changes to Food and Beverage

- To reduce items being touched by multiple people, we are working with hotels and caterers to ensure food and beverage items are distributed safely. This may include individually wrapped items, disposable cups and the presence of an attendant.

Daily Self Assessment will be required prior to entering the training room.
