

2019 SNOW ROADEO

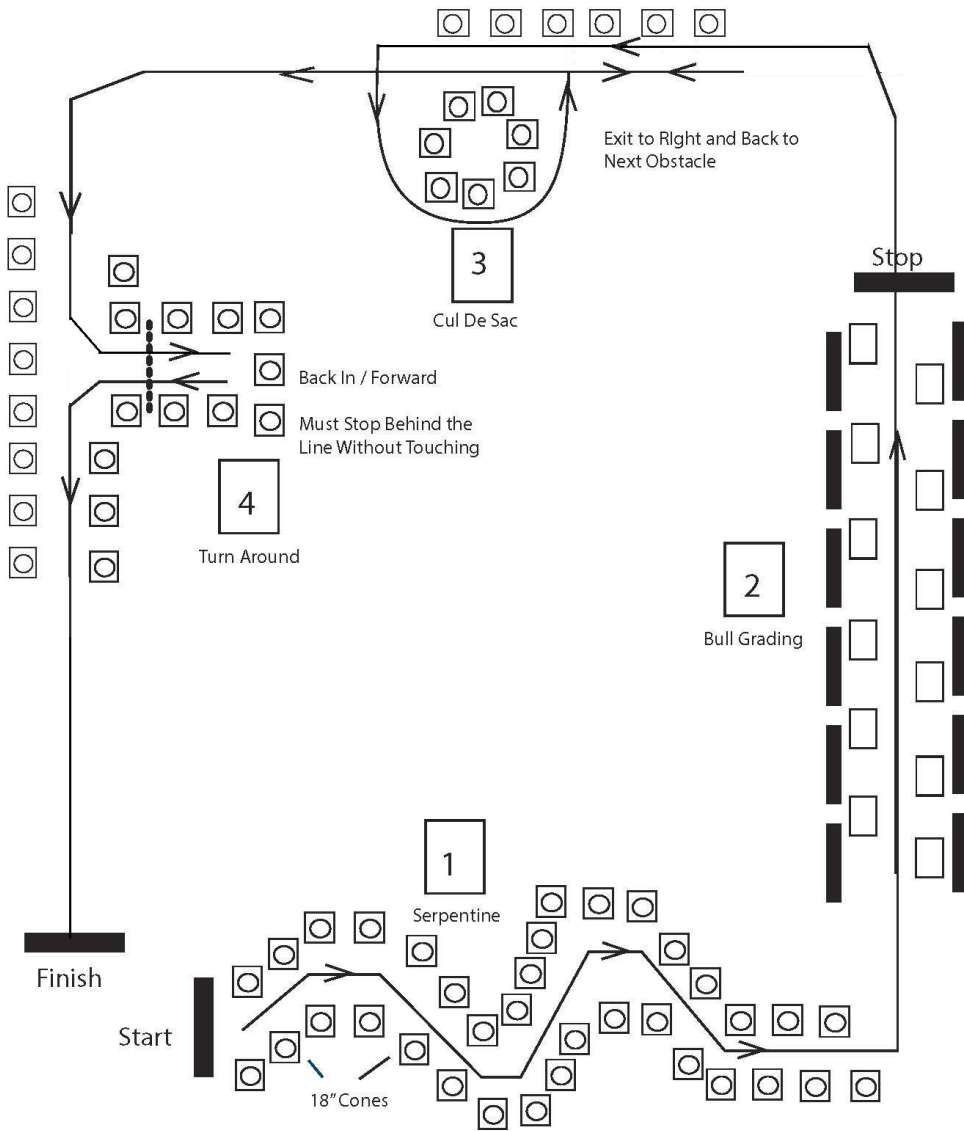
- Course diagram is a guideline only. The equipment used will determine final setup.
- Event will be timed. Time will be determining factor of a tie.
- The maximum time for this event will be ten (10) minutes. If a contestant reaches the maximum allowable time for the event, the official will signal with one long whistle blast, at which time the contestant must stop equipment. The contestant will be awarded points up until the judge has given the time out signal.
- Time stops at finish line when equipment is stopped and contestant sounds the horn once.
- Contestants are expected to drive through course without stopping unless a change in direction is required or stopped by track official. Points will be deducted for every stop.
- Certain obstacles require a measurement from a track official. In such cases, the following instructions apply:
 - When the contestant is satisfied with the position of the vehicle, they shall sound the horn once as a signal to the official that they are ready to be measured.
 - The contestant will hold the equipment stationary until the official completes the required measurements. Measurements shall be taken as quickly and as accurately be made.
 - When the measurements have been completed, the official will give a whistle indicating that the contestant may proceed to the next obstacle.
- No score will be awarded for that obstacle if:
 - A contestant drives obstacle out of sequence.
 - Also, at competitor's discretion, may pass on any obstacle or on any obstacle after attempting to negotiate it.
- **Contestants are expected to operate equipment in a manner befitting professional operations.** Unprofessional and unsafe operation will result in immediate disqualification of contestant.
- Seat belts must be worn at all times.
- Vehicle and equipment must remain in first gear or low range at all times
- No Sticking head out door or window
- No Landmarking
- No excessive speed travelling between obstacles.
- No excessive braking
- No spinning wheels
- No obscene language or obvious displays of temper

NOTE:

- **Any contestant consuming or under the influence of alcohol/drugs during the hours of the Roadeo will be disqualified regardless of circumstances.**
- **Any contestant receiving coaching from the sidelines, through whatever means, will be disqualified from continued participation in the Roadeo. The person's involved in this activity will also be disqualified.**
- **Cellular phone use while participating will result in disqualification.**

Any discrepancies will be solved at the discretion of the Event Coordinator and Main Judge
